

# Scholarships and financial aid

At IQS, people come first and we hope anyone who is motivated and meets the admission requirements can come to study with us regardless of their economic situation or their country of origin.

Our admissions process is currently quite advanced and Academic Excellence scholarships have already been awarded for the 2020-2021 academic year. However, due to the increase in demand for financial aid caused primarily by families affected by COVID-19, IQS has strengthened its scholarship fund and extended the financial aid application deadline. If you have a solid academic record and your family's financial situation requires aid or your family has been directly affected by the consequences of the pandemic, we encourage you to apply for a scholarship to continue advancing your future.

## Terms and conditions to apply for scholarships

To apply for an IQS Undergraduate Scholarship, you must send an email to the IQS General Secretariat at [secretaria.beques@iqs.edu](mailto:secretaria.beques@iqs.edu) with the following documentation:

- a. Filled in printout for the scholarship application, available on our website: [www.iqs.edu](http://www.iqs.edu)
- b. **Official academic** transcripts with the grades obtained in your Baccalaureate or equivalent programme and your University Access Exam (PAU) certificate or UNED transcript. South American or non-EHEA students must submit their academic transcript and the curriculum from their programme.
- c. **Letter of intent** indicating the programme you wish to study or are studying, addressed to the President of the Scholarship Committee, in which the applicant's father, mother, or guardian state the reasons justifying the scholarship application, the family's situation and personal circumstances, as well as any additional information deemed necessary to submit for consideration (financial situation, motivation, inspiration, academic excellence, etc.).
- d. Complete, fully legible photocopy of your family's **tax return** from the preceding financial year. For individual tax returns, you must submit a copy of your mother and father's returns or a certificate stating there was no obligation to file a return.
- e. Photocopy of both your **mother and your father's last payslip** or a photocopy of the last invoice payment received for self-employed individuals. For business owners or self-employed individuals, they must attach the annual activity statement (Form 347) that certifies their earnings from their economic activities.
- f. Document that accrediting the extraordinary economic situation caused by the pandemic.
